#### **ORAL EDUCATION**

We educate children about:

- How to brush
- When to brush
- · How long to brush
- Foods/beverages to avoid

#### ORAL EXAMINATION

We examine:

- Number of teeth
- Check for cavities
- Check for oral conditions
- If your child is brushing well



#### **CLEAN**

We clean:

- Plaque
- Calculus
- Tartar

#### **FLUORIDE**

Once treatment is complete fluoride is placed.

Why use fluoride?

- Strengthens the enamel
- Protects against tooth decay
- Reverses white spots (early decay)

#### FISSURE SEALANTS

A white protective layer placed on the grooves of molars (back teeth) to prevent tooth decay.



#### **REFERRALS**

If there is further treatment that your child needs a referral letter will be sent.

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

- 1. The centre books a preferred day that has high student attendance
- 2. Parents scan the QR code to access the consent forms online
- 3. Parents complete the form online
- 4. Sparkly Smiles checks if the child is <u>eligible</u> for a free check up and clean with the Child Dental Benefits Scheme.
  - If child is not eligible payment options will be available for the parents to fill out

### HOW DO I KNOW IF MY CHILD IS ELIGIBLE UNDER THE DENTAL BENEFITS SCHEME

- 1. Child must be between the ages of 2-17
- Your family is receiving Family Tax Benefit Part A or receiving government payment
- 3. Eigible for Medicare

#### ON THE DAY OF OUR VISIT

- 1. Sparkly Smiles staff (clinician + dental assistant) arrive at 10am
- 2. The Centre only provides: a room, powerpoint and table
- 3. Students participating will be brought together in small groups for their dental check-up.
- 4. Each student will be assessed on their brushing habits, checked for cavities and any oral conditions. All assessments/treatments will be noted on a report.
- 5. Dental reports are emailed a few days later to the parents or given to the students on the day.
